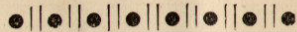

General Notices.

THE CIRCUIT QUARTERLY MEETING will be held at Wesley, on Friday, October 27th, at 6 o'clock. Stewards' Meeting at 3.30. Tea at 5.

The Quarterly Meeting consists of:—1. The Circuit Ministers and all Supernumerary Ministers residing in the Circuit, whose names appear in the printed Minutes of the Conference. 2. The Circuit Stewards, Society Stewards, and Poor Stewards. 3. The Leaders of Adult Society Classes. 4. All Local Preachers of full standing, who are Members of Society in the Circuit. 5. All Trustees of Chapels named in the Circuit Plan, who are Members of Society in the Circuit. 6. The Sunday School Representatives.

THE LOCAL PREACHERS' MEETING will be held at Wesley, on Friday, October 27th, at 2.30 o'clock.

CANDIDATES.—1. Before any Candidate comes upon the Plan for trial, the Superintendent shall certify that he has passed a satisfactory examination in the Second Catechism with the Appendix, and in the Elements of English Grammar.—“Minutes of Conference, 1874.” 2. No Candidate shall be fully admitted as a Local Preacher until he has been twelve months on probation, and has read the Fifty-three Standard Sermons of Mr. Wesley, and his Notes on the New Testament; and has passed a satisfactory examination in the definitions and Scripture proofs of the leading doctrines of Christianity as there explained.—“Minutes of Conference, 1876.”

SUNDAY SCHOOLS.—Representation of Sunday Schools in Circuit Quarterly Meetings:—1. Only Church members of three years' continuous standing are eligible to be elected. 2. Only Members of the Wesleyan Methodist Church shall vote for Representatives. 3. The time and place of the meeting when Representatives are elected shall be fixed in consultation with the Superintendent Minister. — See “Minutes of Conference, 1896,” pp. 373-4.

THE NEW METHODIST HYMN BOOK, PERIODICALS, and all other Publications of the Wesleyan Methodist Book Room, may be obtained through the Superintendent.

MARRIAGES may be solemnized in Wesley, Marlow, Lane End, and Wooburn Chapels. The new Marriage Act is adopted at Wesley, where Marriages can now take place without the attendance of the Registrar.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM.—Both Parents are expected to be present, due notice to be given to Society Stewards, or Caretaker.

N.B.—All communications relating to the next, Plan, whether from Preachers, or others, must be sent to the Superintendent, in writing, NOT LATER than Dec. 9th.

The Duties of Leaders and Stewards.

LEADERS are specially charged with the spiritual oversight of their respective classes. Besides giving suitable counsel at the weekly meeting, it is incumbent upon them to visit their members; to encourage them, as a religious duty, to contribute to the support of the work of God; and to pay the sums received, punctually, to the Society Stewards.

When a Member of Society is about to remove to another Circuit, his Leader should apply to the Minister for a Note of Removal.

Persons wishing to join the Church, and those who are anxiously seeking salvation, are affectionately invited to speak to the Minister, and will be heartily welcomed by any of the Leaders to their Society Classes.

SOCIETY STEWARDS.—Their duties are:—1. To receive from the Leaders the contributions of the members, and to pay them with the Quarterly Collection and any other subscrip-

tions to the Circuit Funds, to the Circuit Stewards before the Quarterly Meeting. 2. To supply the Pulpit with the Notices required by the Plan, and to examine all other notices sent for publication. Notices without their sanction are inadmissible. 3. To see that all Collections are duly announced on the Sabbath preceding and that they are made at the appointed time, from which there shall be no deviation, but with the Superintendent's consent. To take charge of the Circuit and Connexional Collections and enter them in a book kept for that purpose, and to forward the money to the proper persons without unnecessary delay, carefully noting when, and to whom paid. Connexional Collections must be remitted to the Superintendent without delay.

POOR STEWARDS.—Their duties are:—1. To secure the due announcement of the Lord's Supper and the Lovefeast, and to make suitable provision for the same. 2. To receive the collection made on these occasions for the relief of the poor, and to dispense them as directed by the Leaders' Meeting.

CHAPEL STEWARDS.—Their duties are:—To let and re-let the Pews and Sittings, to receive all moneys for the same, and hand them over to the Trustees' Treasurer. 2. To arrange, under the direction of the Superintendent and the Trustees' Meeting, for making Anniversary and other public Collections, as appointed in aid of the Trust Fund. 3. To keep an account of all receipts and payments made by them in behalf of the Trustees. 4. To see that the Trust property is kept in good repair, and insured against loss or damage by fire. 5. To co-operate with the other Stewards in keeping order and promoting the Comfort of the worshippers. 6. To see that the Chapel-keeper properly discharges his duties.

CIRCUIT STEWARDS.—Their duties are:—1. To take charge of all contributions on behalf of the support of the Ministers. 2. To present to the Quarterly Meeting a financial statement showing the receipts and expenditure for the quarter. 3. To pay, in full, to the Ministers, their stipends, and the amount due from the Children's Fund, and to discharge other payments for which the Circuit is liable. 4. To see that suitable houses are provided for the Ministers, and that they are properly and sufficiently furnished. 5. To initiate the invitations to Ministers, and to conduct the correspondence relating thereto. (N.B.—The nomination of Ministers, in the first instance rests exclusively with the Circuit Stewards. On their ceasing or declining to nominate, the matter is altogether in the hands of the Quarterly Meeting). 6. To unite with the Superintendent Minister in auditing, annually, the accounts of all Trust Property, settled under the Chapel Model Deed. Or, if unable to attend the audit meeting of a Trust, to appoint a deputy or deputies. 7. To attend the Annual Meeting of the District Synod in May, during the transaction of its financial affairs, and also the Financial District Synod held in September.

N.B.—Circuit Stewards are members of the Leaders' Meeting of the Society with which they are connected.
